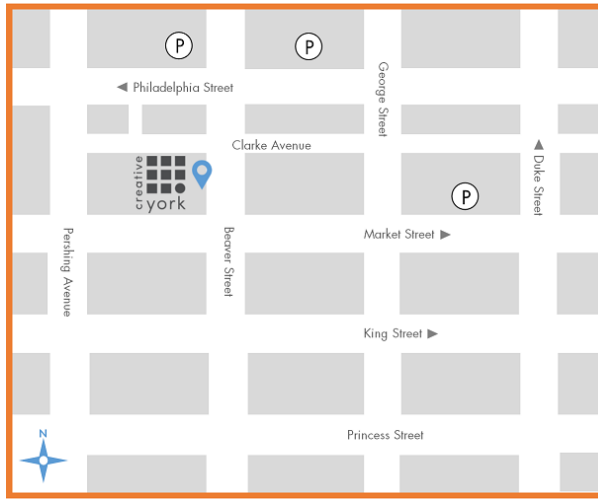

## WRITER'S EYE ENTRY FORM

### RULES FOR ENTRY

The Writer's Eye Competition links the inspiration of writers to the creative vision of artists. Participants are invited to write a poem or short story in response to the Transformation exhibit at Creative York. Writers are invited to take a self guided tour or to schedule a group to visit the gallery. The Writer's Eye competition begins September 28, 2017 and runs until November 18, 2017. The competition is open to students in grades 4-12, college students, and adults. Entry forms should accompany submissions. First, second, and third-place ribbons are awarded in each of four age categories. Deadline to submit work is Saturday, January 13, 2018 by 2:00pm. An awards ceremony will be held on Friday, March 9, 2018 at 6:00pm in the Kerlin Gallery. Winning works are also published in the Writer's Eye booklet.

### About the Exhibit

In the Kerlin Gallery  
Transitions features the work of various artists using different mediums to explore form, texture and movement in their artwork.

In the Project Space  
Off Canvas Experiments: printmaking and sculptures by Judeth Pekala Hawkins who uses collections of objects from nature and things meant to be discarded to create three-dimensional work.

### RULES FOR ENTRY

Type entries, double spaced, either hard copy or digital copy.  
Submit TWO copies. One of your submissions must be anonymous (with no name or address). Include the title of your work and the title of the work of art that inspired it on every page. Your submission must have an entry form stapled to one copy of the work.  
Stories are limited to 1,000 words.  
Entries must be an original, never before published work by the author.  
Writers grant Creative York permission to publish their work in any catalog or educational publication.  
Only one entry is allowed per writer.  
Participants can visit the gallery as a group or individually.  
Entries must be received by 2:00pm on 1/13/18
