



CALL FOR WORKS: IDENTITY EXHIBIT

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

IDENTITY is an exhibit of artworks examining individual identity, be it cultural, historical, gender-based, physical, mental, or any of the many other elements that shape and define who we are as individuals and human beings. The exhibit will run in The Kerlin Gallery at Creative York from February 28, 2019 to April 20, 2019, with an opening reception on Thursday, February 28 from 6-8pm. There is no submission fee for this exhibition.

STANDARDS & ELIGIBILITY

Submission to the exhibit is open to all artists and crafts persons over 18 years of age, located in the continental United States. Original fine art and fine craft in all mediums (2D, 3D, digital, sound) are acceptable. Work should be of high quality and craftsmanship. The final selection of artwork for the exhibit rests with the curator(s).

RULES FOR ENTRY

- Up to three submission entries permitted per artist.
- All submissions must be received by Midnight on Sunday, February 10, 2019.
- All submissions must include:
 - Properly labeled digital images
 - Completed Submission Form (found at creativeyork.org/gallery/artists)
 - Artist Statement for each entry about how it relates to the IDENTITY theme
 - Artist Bio
- All entries must be submitted via email or on CD or flash drive in jpeg format at 300 dpi and not larger than 3MB in size. Please label each file with artist's name and entry number. (Example: jones_1.jpg). The file names must correspond to your entry form. Please write "IDENTITY Exhibit" and artist's name on CD or flash drive.

All submission entries must be of work available for the exhibition.
